Cerebral Palsy

- CP is the most common disability in childhood
- 17 million people live with CP worldwide
- 3 in 4 children with CP are in pain
- 1 in 2 children with CP dies before 18 years of age
- 1 in 2 children with CP has intellectual disability
- 1 in 3 children with CP cannot walk
- 1 in 3 children with CP has a hip displacement
- 1 in 4 children with CP cannot talk
- 1 in 4 children with CP has epilepsy
- 1 in 4 children with CP has a behavior disorder
- 1 in 4 children with CP has bladder control problems
- 1 in 5 children with CP has a sleep disorder
- 1 in 5 children with CP dribbles
- 1 in 10 children with CP is blind
- 1 in 15 children with CP is tube-fed
- 1 in 25 children with CP is deaf

Prevalence

- 12% in children with hypoxic-ischemic encephalopathy after birth
- 10% in children born before 28 weeks of gestation
- 5% in children born between 28 31 weeks of gestation
- 0,7% in children born between 31 37 weeks of gestation
- 0,1% in children born at term
